- Case management
- Nutritional support
- Medication management

- Medicaid-covered service
- Transportation available



How does a medical day program differ from a social day program?

	Medical Day Program	Social Day Program
Population Served	Adults 21 and over requiring medical services	Older adults who may be socially isolated or need supervision.
Program Goals	Medical monitoring assessment, treatment and education. Chronic disease management. Supervision, socialization, nutrition and community services linkages.	Supervision, socialization, nutrition and community services linkages.
Required Staffing	Professional Registered nurse, licensed social worker, certified nurses aide, registered dietitian, licensed therapists (Physical, Occupational, Speech). Consultant Pharmacist. Medical Director.	No No universal staff licensing or certifications required.
Requirements:		
Licensed and Certification	Yes Licensed under skilled nursing facility. Regulated by NYS Department of Health.	No No universal review or certification.
Medical Need Required	Yes Require a medical need for this program.	No No medical need to qualify.
Doctors Orders	Yes Participants must be approved by an MD and assessed by a Registered Nurse.	No No MD approvals or assessments required.
Reimbursement	Primarily Medicaid although private insurance and private pay permitted.	Not a Medicaid eligible service.
