Saturday 12/1: Metropolitan Opera at Shoppingtown Mall;

The Magic Flute

Julie Taymor's dazzling production returns to select cinemas this holiday season in an encore presentation. James Levine conducts a winning ensemble including Matthew Polenzani, Nathan Gunn, and René Pape in this abridged, English-language version of Mozart's classic fable. Runtime is 2 hours. Language: English, with English subtitles.

Friday 12/14: Symphoria Pops; *Magic of the Holidays*

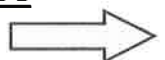
