Friday 1/11: Skä•noñh Great Law of Peace Center & Lunch Outing

The Skä•noñh – Great Law of Peace Center is a Haudenosaunee (Iroquois) Heritage Center focused on telling the story of the native peoples of central New York. The history is told through the lens of the Onondaga Nation and covers topics such as Creation, European Contact, The Great Law of Peace, and more. Skä•noñh, is an Onondaga welcoming greeting meaning “Peace and Wellness.” After a guided tour, we’ll go to The Retreat for lunch.
