Directed by: Jason Alexander. Jason Robert Brown's emotionally powerful and intimate musical about two young New Yorkers who fall in and out of love. Cathy is an aspiring musical theatre performer, Jamie a novelist whose star is on the rise. He tells their story from the beginning, she from the end. With beautiful music and alternately humorous and heartfelt lyrics, *The Last Five Years* is a sincere and unflinching expression of love gained and lost.

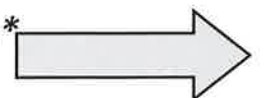
Cost: \$31 ticket. Transportation leaves at 1:00pm for the 2pm show. Please sign-up and have your money in by Monday 6/10.
