Join other Loretto communities at the Cunningham Auditorium for a special game of Name That Tune Joe Trionfero. Light refreshments will be served.

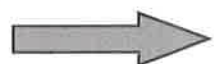
**Cost:** FREE. Bus leaves at 2:00pm. Please sign-up by Thurs. 5/17.
